2019 Brings Higher Minimum Wage in California

Effective January 1, the minimum wage for employers with more than 25 employees is increased to \$12 per hour. The new minimum hourly rate for employers with 25 employees or less is \$11 per hour.

California's minimum wage will continue to increase over time until it reaches \$15 per hour statewide by 2023. The current federal minimum wage is \$7.25 per hour. That rate has not been changed since 2009.
